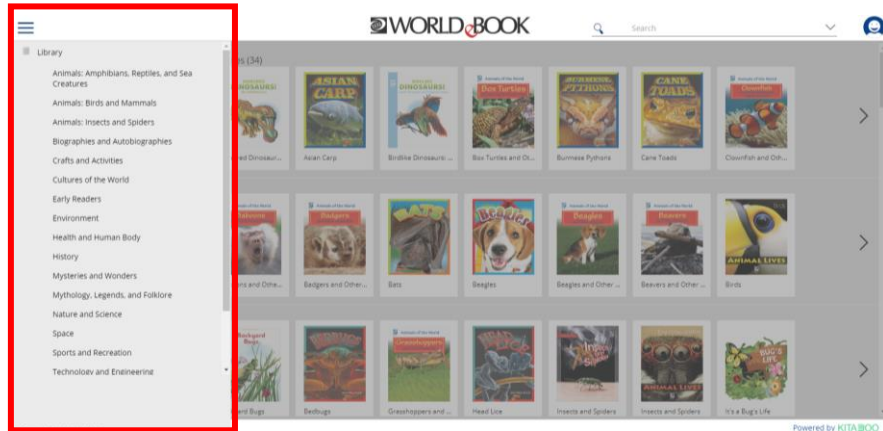


How to search...

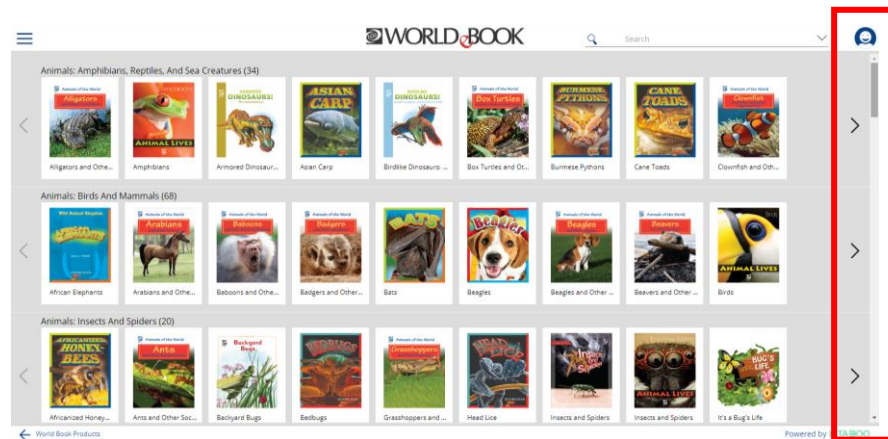
There are a number of different ways to search on World eBooks.

1. Search via subject:

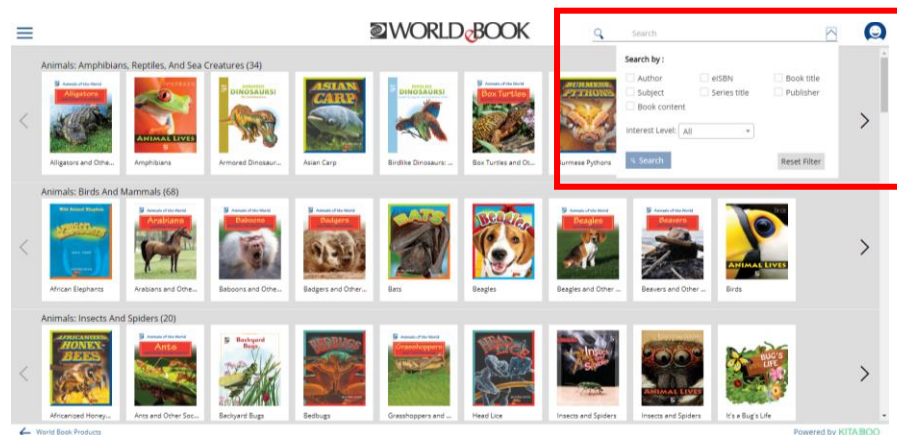


2. Search via image:

Use the scroll bar and arrows to navigate through all the titles available.



3. Narrow your search by using the search bar and menu:

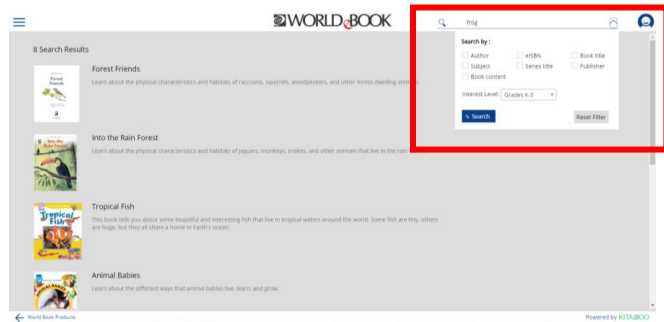


Search by:

- **Keyword** by typing a keyword in the search bar.
- Clicking **Author** and type author's name in the search bar e.g. William Shakespeare.
- Clicking **Subject** and type in a subject in the search bar e.g. animals, nature and science, history, environment, health and human body.
- Clicking **Book content** and type a search term e.g. frog in the search bar.
- Clicking **eISBN** and type in the eISBN of the title you are searching for in the search bar.
- Clicking **Series title** and type in the series name in the search bar e.g. Building Blocks of Science.

- Clicking *Book title* and type in a title in the search bar e.g. *Aboriginal Rights Movement*.
- Clicking *Publisher* e.g. World Book to bring up World Book only titles.
- Clicking *Interest level* and select the age range in the drop down menu.

You can also combine your search by clicking multiple boxes
e.g. Keyword: Frog ; Interest Level: K-3



Don't forget to click the 'search' button when you're ready to search!

You can reset your search by clicking the 'Reset Filter' button.
