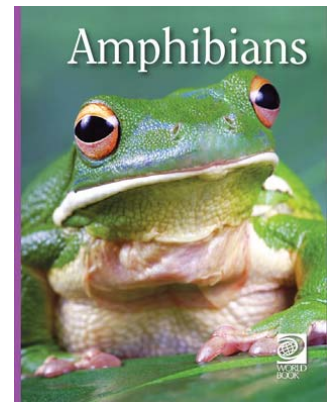


Animal Lives – Amphibians Activity Sheet
