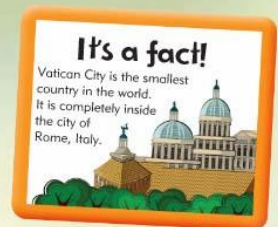
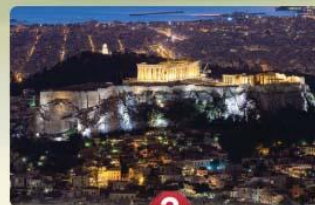
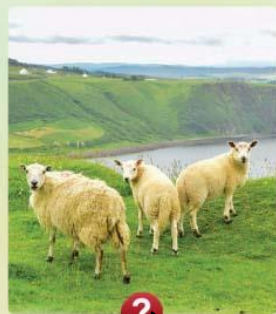
# Europe
