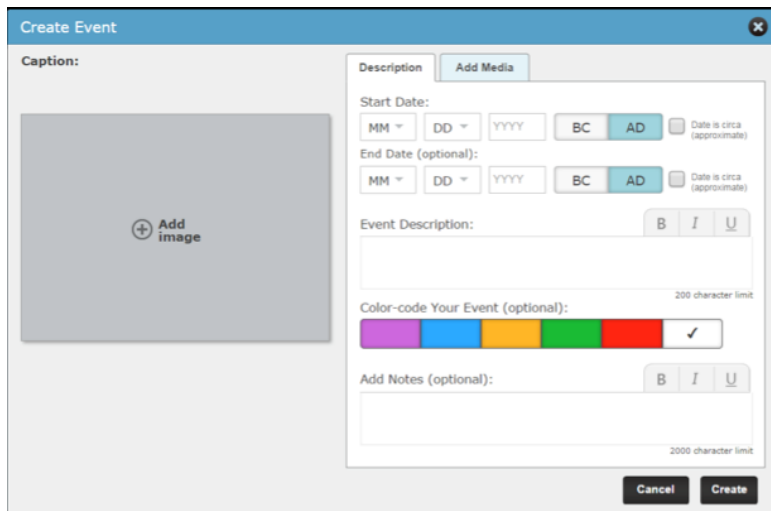
- Click "Create a Timeline" to create a timeline.



- Click "Create an Event" to enter in an event

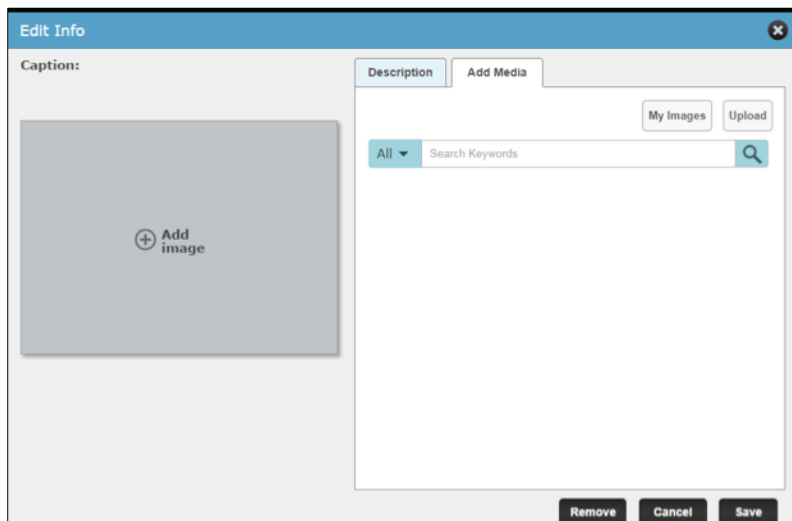


- Provide the date and summary of the event that happened during that time. You can add images and additional facts about the event too.

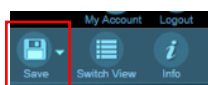


To add images to do with Ottoman Empire to your event:

	1908	Constitution guaranteeing an elected parliamentary government is reinstated	A group of military officers called the Young Turks forced the reinstating of the constitution.
	1914	Empire consists of only Asia Minor, parts of south-western Asia, and part of the Balkans.	-
	1918	Ottoman forces who fought on the side of Germany and Italy lose World War I	The Ottoman Empire is occupied by Allied nations.
