

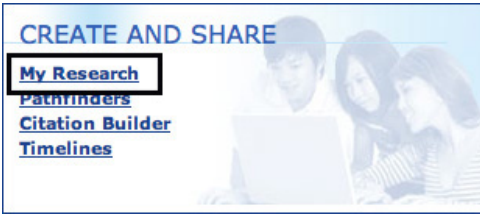

A "forgot my password" function is available to help users who have lost their passwords.

- World Book articles, images, primary source books, and ebooks can be saved to a user's **My Research** page. The list of content types will display in the left hand column.
- The **Tools box** at the top of the page includes options to print, e-mail, and save content.
- The My Research page features a **personalised welcome message**.
- Users can delete entries, and can **annotate** each content piece with a note – a reminder, a detail to follow up on later, or other information to save for later reference.
- Images** from World Book Online can be saved to a user's My Research page.
- Users can enter **bibliographic information** about books they've found in their research.
- Users can add **Web sites** for sites they've found in their research.
- Citations** created from the Citation Builder can be saved to My Research pages.
