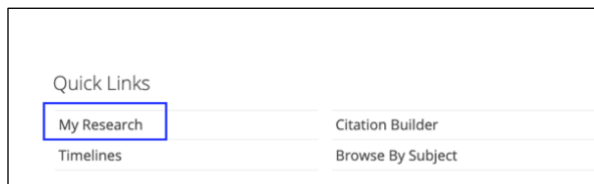


## HOW TO CREATE A MY WORLD BOOK ACCOUNT

This is a one-time setup. Once you complete the steps below, you will be able to save articles, media, and citations directly to **My Research** in Student and Advanced. If you have *eBooks*, this account also allows students to save *eBooks* to 'Favourites' and easily access notes and annotations on books from any device!

1. Log in to *World Book Online*. Login method varies by account. If you are not sure the method your school or library uses, email [info@worldbook.com.au](mailto:info@worldbook.com.au), or contact your Educational Sales Consultant.
2. Enter *Student* or *Advanced*.
3. Click **My Research**. In *Student* this is found on the home page under **Quick Links**. In *Advanced* this is found under the **Research and Resources** menu.




4. Select **Create an account**.
