What is the **salient image** on the front cover – what do you first look at – *the title, the picture, the publisher (World Book) or the series (Bolt)*. **Underline** your answer

1. **Why** did you choose that – was it because of its *size; position on the cover; colours* used. **Underline** your answer
2. What **colour** stands out the most on the cover of your book?
3. Look at the **title** – does the use of *the spotty background* behind the title make the title stand out **more** or **less**? **Underline** your answer
