4. Charlemagne shared rule of the Frankish Kingdom with his brother. What was his brother's name and in what year did his brother die?

5. What year did Charlemagne become the sole ruler of the Frankish kingdom?

6. Upon his succession to the throne, Charlemagne immediately began expanding his kingdom. Over the course of his reign he conquered territories throughout Europe. His longest campaign was against the Saxons. Approximately, how many years were they at war and what years did they run through?

7. Charlemagne's campaigns extended to Spain. In what year were his rear guard ambushed and wiped out by the Basques people?

8. Following decades of campaigns, Charlemagne's realm extended from central Italy north to Denmark and from eastern Germany west to the Atlantic Ocean. In what year was this achieved?

9. Charlemagne followed a policy of friendship and cooperation with the Christian church. Pope Leo III crowned Charlemagne emperor of the Romans on what date?

11. Following his death, Charlemagne’s kingdom gradually fell apart. What happened in 843?

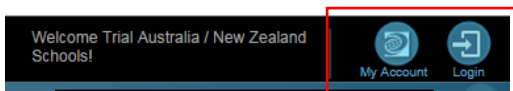
12. Over what period did Charlemagne build his kingdom?

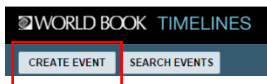

- Click “Create an Event” to enter in an event

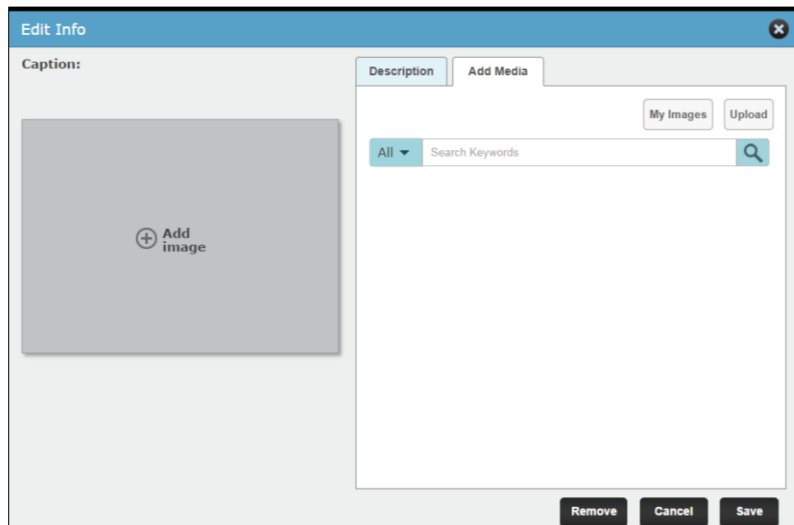


- Provide the date and summary of the event that happened during that time. You can add images and additional facts about the event too.

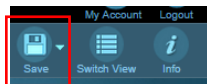
