6. In what year was Ned Kelly convicted of assault?

7. In 1871, shortly after his release from prison, Ned Kelly was convicted of another crime. What crime was he convicted of committing?

8. When was he released from prison for committing this crime?

9. In what month and year is it claimed that police officer, Andrew Fitzpatrick, was shot at the Kelly home?

10. In what year were three police officers killed while trying to capture or kill Ned and his brother, who had escaped to the bush after the incident with Andrew Fitzpatrick?

11. Name the members of the Kelly Gang?

12. When did the Kelly Gang rob a bank in Euroa, Victoria?

13. Two months later, the Kelly Gang raided the town of Jerilderie. What month and year did this happen?

14. In what month and year did the Kelly Gang take over the railway village of Glenrowan, which resulted in a siege with over 50 police officers?

15. Ned Kelly was captured following the siege and stood trial for murder on what date?

16. After being found guilty, Ned Kelly was hanged in Melbourne jail on what date?


17. Use your answers to make a Timeline of Ned Kelly's life.
